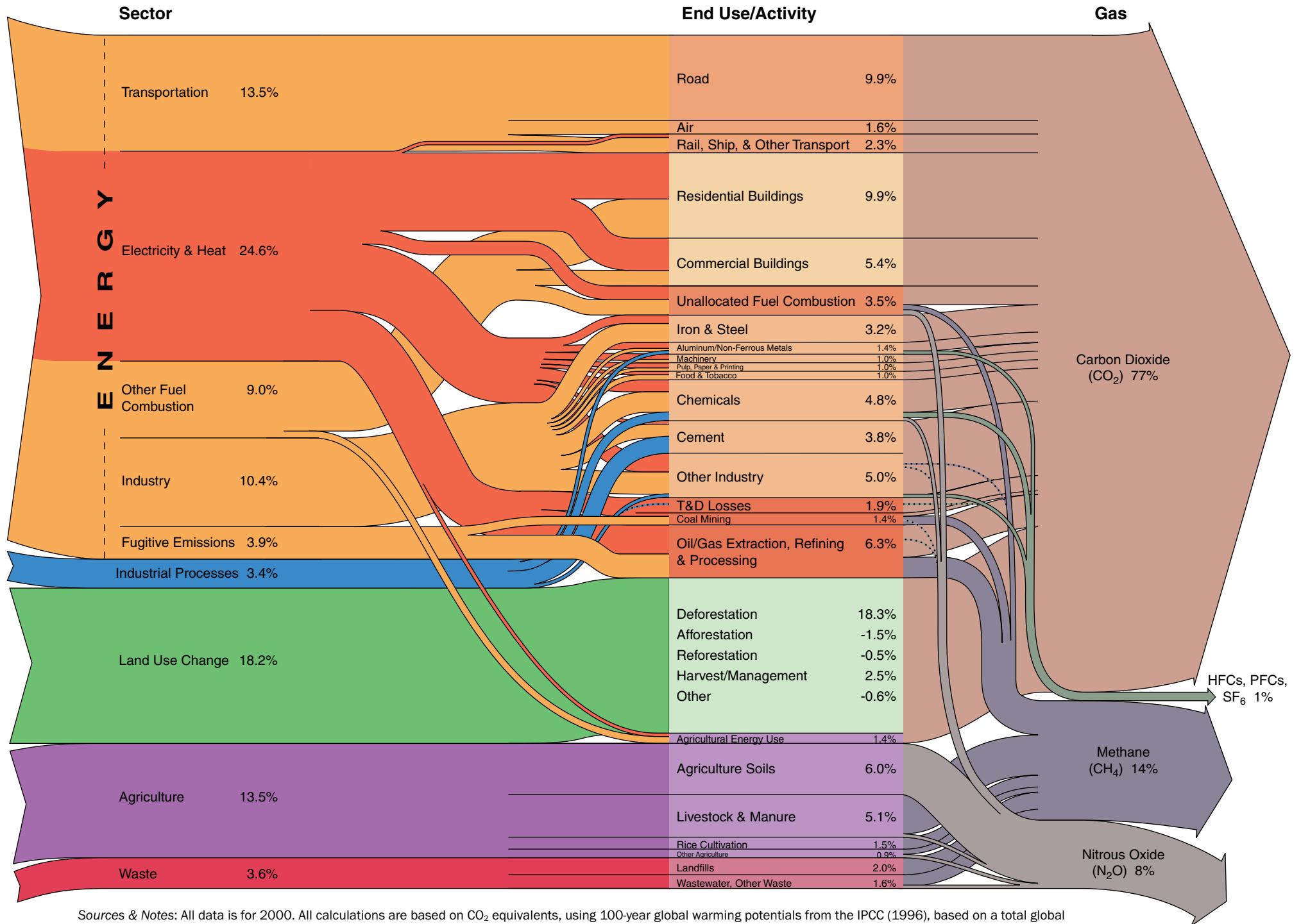


World greenhouse gas emissions flow chart (the “spaghetti chart”)

All calculations are based on CO₂ equivalents, using 100-year global warming potentials from the IPCC (1996), based on a total global estimate of 41 755 Mt CO₂ equivalent. Dotted lines represent flows of less than 0.1% of total GHG emissions. Land-use change includes both emissions and absorptions.
